I am counsel for the Nonhuman Rights Project, Inc. (NhRP) in this matter. I am writing to advise you that the NhRP will withdraw its habeas corpus petition on behalf of Missy, Kimba, Lucky, LouLou, and Jambo if Respondents agree to allow the elephants to be transferred to an elephant sanctuary accredited by the Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries (GFAS).

Should Respondents agree, I want to emphasize that they would <u>not</u> bear any costs for the transfer. Additionally, the NhRP will be happy to assist Respondents in any way we can and will publicly convey our appreciation for their actions.

I look forward to hearing from you, and hope that we can reach an agreement to secure the release of Missy, Kimba, Lucky, LouLou, and Jambo to a GFAS-accredited sanctuary as quickly as possible. Thank you.
